CURRICULUM

2013 - 2014

Using the Tennessee Early Learning Standards as a developmentally appropriate guide line, our Tennessee Licensed, Three Star center, uses a curriculum that incorporates the importance of learning through play while following the children's current interests. The teachers plan their classroom with center activities which include music, dramatic play, large and small motor skills, science, math, beginning reading skills, as well as art. The environment supports the children intellectually as well as emotionally, preparing them for years of successful learning ahead. There are two meeting planned per year to review our teaching methods and successes for teaching your children.

Each day additional activities in the form of small or large groups are also planned. A monthly calendar is sent home from each classroom with a short description of each day's events.

Our Bible curriculum consists of a bible story, bible point and memory verse for the children each month. These are read in a simple story book form with no religious affiliation. Dr. Mark Bryan, Pastor at Glen Leven Presbyterian Church leads a 30 minute Chapel Service each Monday morning at 9:30 am. You are always welcome to join us for this special time together.

Bible Curriculum 2013-14 School Year

August

The Lost Son

(The story of the prodigal son as found in the Gospel of Luke.)

Memory Verse: For this son of mine was dead and has now returned to life. He was lost, but now he is found. Luke 15:24

Bible Point: God always loves us no matter what.

September

Jesus and his Friends

(The story of Jesus' disciples found in Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.)

Memory Verse: You must Love one another, just as I have loved you. John 13:34

Bible Point: God wants us to love each other.

October

Joseph and His Brothers

(The story of Joseph, his coat of many colors and the how the Israelites came to Egypt. Found in Genesis.)

Memory Verse: This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you. John 15:12.

Bible Point: God wants us to love everyone.

November

Jesus Feeds the People

(The story of how Jesus feed the multitudes with two fish and five loaves of bread. Found in Mark and Matthew.)

Memory Verse: How great your goodness is! Psalm 31:19

Bible Point: God provides

December

Baby Jesus is Born

(The story of Jesus Birth. As found in Luke.)

Memory Verse: Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to men. Luke 2:14

Bible Point: God sent Jesus so we could all go to heaven

January

Queen Esther Help's God's People

(The Story of how Esther became queen and saved the Jewish people from Haman's evil plan. From the book of Esther.)

Memory Verse: Who Knows? It's possible that you became queen for a time just like this.

Esther 4:14

Bible Point: God does everything for a reason.

February

Moses and the King

(The story of Moses convincing the Pharaoh to let the Israelites leave Egypt for the Promised Land. As found in Exodus.)

Memory Verse: I will take you to be my own people. Exodus 6:7

Bible Point: God will take care of us.

March

Daniel and the Lions

(The story of Daniel spending the night in a lion's den and of how God protected them. Told in Daniel.)

Memory Verse: My God sent his angel. And his angel shut the mouths of the lions. They haven't hurt me at all. Daniel 6:22

Bible point: God takes care of us.

April

Jesus Saves the World

(The story of Jesus' crucifixion, and resurrection. As told in John.)

Memory Verse: : I am the way the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6

Bible Point: Jesus' died so we could go to heaven.

May

Adam and Eve in the Garden

(The story of creation from the book of Genesis.)

Memory Verse: God saw everything he had made and it was good. Genesis 1:31

Bible point: God created everything.
